Cracking little red vin de table from this top Chateauneuf du Pape producer. Light red fruit with plenty of spice and fresh acidity.		
65 2007 Monte Haro - Rioja Tinto - Bodegas Paternina (Spain)		16.75
The youngest red from this old Bodega. Soft and fruity it has the tiniest amount of Barrel ageing which puts it head and shoulders above most Rioja Tinto..		
66 2007 Villa Wolf Pinot Noir - Dr Loosen - Pfalz Germany		17.95
True Pinot Noir character, smooth and fruity with a good spicy finish. Light with plenty of acidity.		
67 2007 Carmenere Reserva - de Gras - Chile		19.25
Rediscovered grape variety that has been living well in Chile for over 100 years, big black fruit flavours with underlying spice and vanilla.		
68 2005 'La Montesa' Rioja Crianza - Bodegas Palacios Remondo		23.95
One of the older bodegas, floral nose, good fruit flavours of strawberry and Plum. The finish is polished with cedar and vanilla.		
69 2006 Redstone Shiraz - Coriole McLaren Vale Australia		24.50
Classic Australian shiraz, tons of rich black fruit, spicy full with a chocolate finish.		
70 2004 Quinary - Raka - South Africa		25.75
A blend of five Bordeaux grapes this is deep in colour with rich blackcurrant and cassis, a little chocolate with good structure and well balanced acids.

73 2005 Hollick Cabernet Merlot - Coonawarra Australia Coonawarra is famous for its Cabernet Sauvignon and here it is blended with a little Merlot. Typical blackcurrant fruit silky tannins and a rounded finish.		26.50
